A basic kit of materials to get you up and going is listed here. Specialist art shops are the best option and will provide student discounts if you mention that you are attending the school. Recommended stores are:

Required

Small bottle black Indian Ink (eg 30ml)

A range of coloured or acrylic inks (min. 2 additional colours)

Dip pen and 2-3 variations of nib/OR $2-3 \times good$ quality permanent ink writing pens in a variety of line widths eg Staedtler, Sharpies, Faber Castell Pitt artist pens, simple everyday biros

Brushes: as a minimum $1 \times$ small and $1 \times$ med. sized round pointed brush, $1 \times$ med. flat brush (2-5mm) Low tack masking tape (lilac)

Wet strength or watercolour paper in a range of different sizes (can be hot or cold pressed). Suggest a pad of 250-300gsm A5 watercolour paper (min. 8 sheets) and a larger sized (A3 or A4) 300gsm Fabriano mixed media pad

Good quality drawing paper

Optional

Additional coloured ink/s

Old toothbrush

A large feather

Masking fluid

A white crayon or wax candle

Your own alcohol ink/s and Yupo paper or high gloss photocopy paper

Visual diary or notebook

Other materials if desired
