

Materials list

A basic kit of materials to get you up and going is listed here. Specialist art shops are the best option and will provide student discounts if you mention that you are attending the school.

The stores we recommend are:

- Studio Art Supplies - Crummer Road, Grey Lynn.
 - The French Art Shop – Taylors Road, Morningside
 - Gordon Harris - Gillies Avenue, Newmarket and Symonds Street, Auckland Central.
 - Takapuna Art Supplies – Helensville, or online
 - Warehouse Stationery – has Winton oil paint
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Students need to bring:

- an apron or old shirt
- Exacto or cutting knife

heavy weight paper to print on (not have too much tooth to it)

- Inks
- Mark-making tools
- Paper to get us started with
