Materials needed:

Paints: oil or acrylic

- Ivory Black,
- Titanium White,
- Yellow Ochre
- Cadmium Red Light (or Hue)
- Ultramarine Blue
- Burnt Umber

Plus an acrylic earth colour like Raw Umber.

- Painting knife (metal, medium size, with elbow)_
- Flat palette (big, wood) if possible with a Dipper.
- Rags, linseed oil (if using oils)
- Brushes: preferably synthetic, flat and filbert, various sizes including one at least 2cm wide
- 4-5 boards, canvases, canvas boards, MDF, hardboard or heavy card: primed/sized ready to go. Various sizes 20 40cms, any aspect.
- White Gesso
- GAC 100 if using bare MDF boards or other absorbent supports.

At Browne School of Art we also have a selection of basic materials available for purchase as you go: paper in A1 / A2 sheets: newsprint, cartridge, sugar grey, wet strength, bulldog clips, pencils, charcoal, erasers, white chalk, black ink.
