Your preferred drawing kit or

Willow charcoal
Compressed charcoal
Kneadable eraser, pencil eraser

Oil Paint:

Titanium white (larger size)
Lemon yellow
Cadmium yellow
Yellow ochre
Cadmium red
Alizarin crimson
Cobalt blue
French ultra marine

Brushes

Hog hair Flat: small (5mm), medium (10mm), large(20-30mm)
Filbert or round 8, 10, 12 and any smaller sizes if you like detail.

1 canvas or canvas panel 400 x 500mm or thereabouts.

Medium

Odourless turpentine / linseed oil mixed 50:50

or

a propriety medium such as Shminke Medium number 1. (Studio Art Supplies or Gordon Harris)
