Materials:

Acrylic paints:

a variety colours i.e. primary colours: yellow, red, blue, black and white (as minimum).
Students are also encouraged to bring along additional favourite colours if desired.

A2, A3 or A4 drawing/sketch pad

A4 or A5 watercolour pad: 250-300gsm (or a 250-300gsm mixed media pad eg Fabriano)

Paintbrushes:

1x small and 1x med. sized pointed brush,

1x med. flat brush (2-8cm wide),

1x med. flat hog hair/bristle (1-3cm wide)

Low-tack lilac masking tape

Optional:

Palette knife or spatula

Old bankcard or a scraper

Toothbrush

Additional brushes as desired eg fan, filbert, angled, etc

Own acrylic mediums such as modelling paste, glazing fluid, gel medium, etc
