



Asthma, Allergy & Medication Statement

I am committed to supporting children with asthma, allergies and other medical needs so that they can participate safely and confidently in Breathe with Bee sessions.

Parents/carers must disclose any relevant medical information, allergies or medication requirements at the time of booking. Where additional support or medication may be required during sessions, Breathe with Bee will contact parents/carers directly to gather further information and obtain the necessary consent.

Medication During Sessions

Medication required during Breathe with Bee sessions must:

- Be provided by the parent/carer or designated school staff member at the beginning of the session
- Be clearly labelled with the child's full name
- Be in date and supplied in its original packaging where appropriate
- Include clear instructions regarding dosage and administration

Medication will be kept in an accessible location throughout the session and returned directly to the parent/carer or designated school staff member at collection/drop off to class. Breathe with Bee does not store medication between sessions.

Children who are able to self-administer prescribed medication, such as inhalers, may do so under the supervision of the instructor where parental consent has been provided.

Bee's Yoga Ambassadors do not administer, supervise or have responsibility for medication at any time.

Emergency Procedures

In the event of a medical emergency, medication will be administered or supervised in accordance with the information and consent provided by the parent/carer.

Where appropriate, emergency services will be contacted and parents/carers informed as soon as reasonably practicable.

Parent/Carer Responsibilities

Parents/carers are responsible for:

- Providing accurate and up-to-date medical information
- Informing Breathe with Bee of any changes to their child's medical needs
- Providing any required medication for the duration of the session
- Ensuring that medication is clearly labelled, in date and suitable for use

Confidentiality & Record Keeping

Medical information is collected only where necessary to support the safe delivery of sessions. Information is handled sensitively, stored securely and managed in line with UK data protection requirements.

Medication handovers and any administration of medication during sessions will be recorded appropriately.

Linked Health & Safeguarding Reference

This statement should be read in conjunction with the Breathe with Bee Safeguarding Statement, Health & Safety Statement and Booking Terms & Refund Policy.

Where a concern involves both medical needs and safeguarding considerations, safeguarding procedures take priority and are followed in line with local and statutory guidance.
