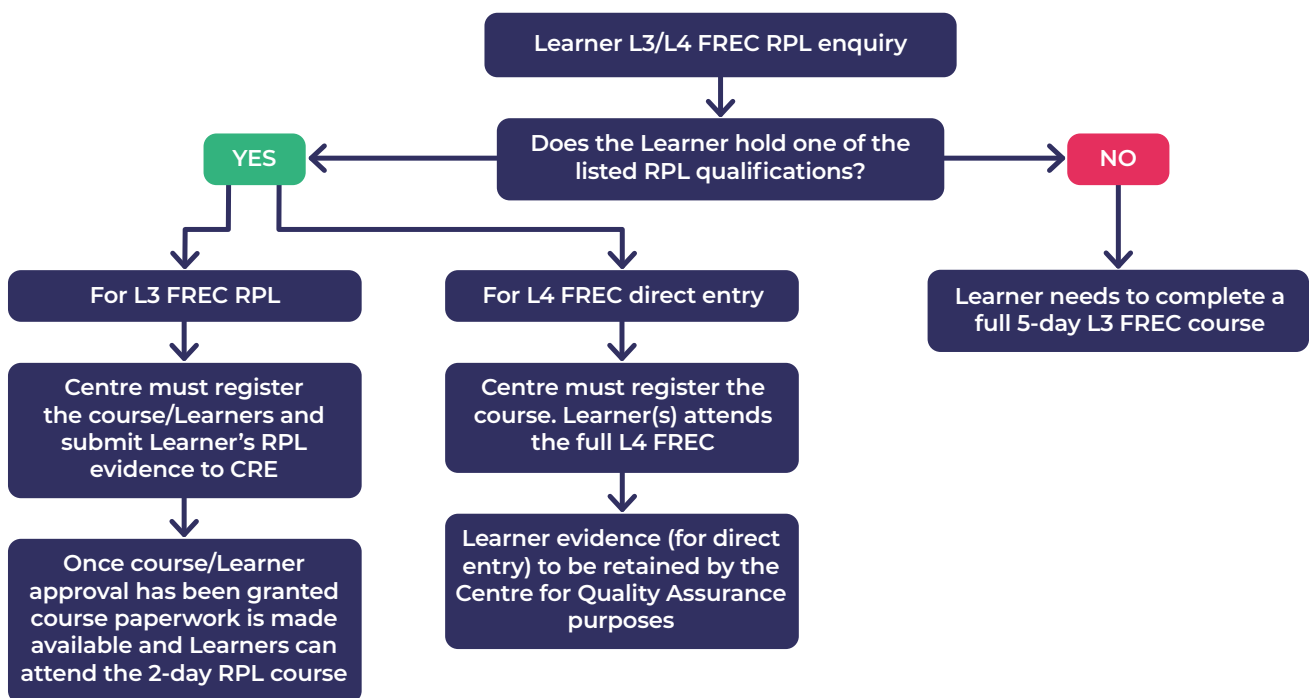


Centre Checklist

As we receive many requests from FREC Learners, either seeking to attend a shortened FREC3 course or claiming direct entry onto FREC4 due to their prior learning, we have carried out comprehensive mapping against both regulated qualifications and unregulated courses (for emergency services first responders). This guidance provides clarification on the

1. regulated qualifications we accept so that Learners can attend a 2-day FREC3 RPL course, which covers the knowledge and skills not contained within that qualification.*
2. unregulated casualty care/first responder courses we accept so that Learners can attend a 2-day FREC3 RPL course*
3. regulated qualifications and roles/courses we recognise as FREC3 equivalents that allows direct entry onto FREC4

***Important note:** All Learners must have completed their course/qualification within 24 months of the FREC3 course start date and are still required to complete all FREC3 assessments.

- Pearson BTEC Level 4 Certificate for First Person on Scene (FPOS) (603/0513/7)
- Pearson BTEC Level 4 Extended Certificate for First Person on Scene (FPOS) (603/0512/5)
- Qualsafe/FAQ Level 3 Diploma in Ambulance Emergency and Urgent Care Support (RQF)

Approved role/course recognition for direct entry to Level 4 FREC

- Emergency Care Assistant/Ambulance Support Worker (Emergency) with 12 months operational frontline experience currently employed by an Ambulance Service NHS Trust
- Army – Combat Medical Technician – Class 1, Royal Air Force Medic, Royal Navy or Royal Marine – Medical Assistant (must be currently serving or has left the military medic role within the 24 months)

Important note: NMC Registered Nurses with CPD activity covering the content of FREC3 wanting direct entry to FREC4 are required to undertake FREC3 assessments (as a minimum) prior to registering on a FREC4 course.
