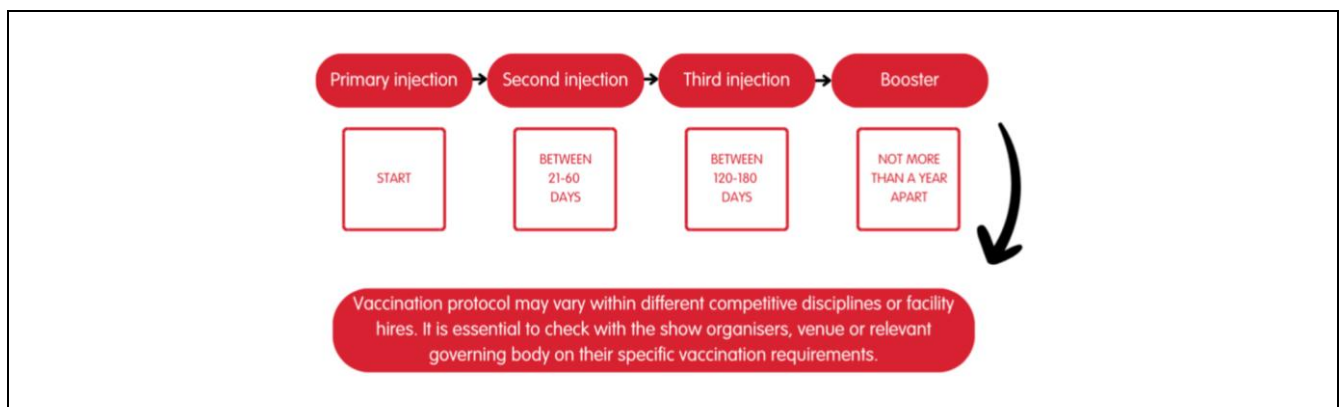

Information for attendees regarding Equine Influenza -

- No horses should travel from premises with a current outbreak of Equine Influenza
- Be familiar with the [signs of flu](#)
- Disinfect all equipment regularly especially when travelling
- Wash and sanitize hands regularly
- Avoid unnecessary contact between horses
- Avoid unnecessary contact with equipment
- Check your horse's vaccination status and consider bringing boosters forward to 6 months – speak to your vet for advice
- **All horses must be up to date with annual equine influenza vaccinations and must be 6 days clear from their most recent booster vaccination.** Further vaccination guidance can be found <https://www.bhs.org.uk/horse-care-and-welfare/health-care-management/horse-health/equine-diseases/equine-influenza/> **Please note that a photograph of your horse's passport with the vaccinations confirmed will be required before the event day, and the passport itself will then be checked on the day, prior to unloading.**

- Owners should check their horse's temperature twice daily for 3 days prior to travel, closely monitored after an event
- We encourage owners to temperature check on arrival and give information to organiser if requested. If your horse's temperature is above 38.5 degrees – please go home directly. We encourage owners to take temperatures regularly and get to know what is normal for your horse(s)

- Event organisers reserve the right to spot check horses temperatures and/or ask attendee/horse to leave if necessary
- It is a legal requirement to have your horse's passport with you when travelling to events.
- Attendees to wear clean clothes while attending
- Please arrive, ride and then leave promptly
