Foxhill Dog Training Arena, Foxhill Dog Park, Off B730, KA1 5SH

Directions

From Glasgow, leave the A77 at Dundonald exit, just after entering the 50mph speed zone. Follow the signs towards Dundonald Castle to T Junction. Turn right towards Kilmarnock and then first left towards Dundonald onto B730. After passing Dankeith Cemetery on left hand side, drop down the hill and turn right into Muirmill Equestrian Centre. Immediately turn right again into Foxhill Dog Park.

Note: if you miss turning to dog park you can enter Muirmill to turn around but please secure the gates.

Use dog park carpark and toilet your dog on the grass. Keep your dog on lead in this area. The portable toilet is also located in the carpark alongside the water tap.

**PLEASE LEAVE YOUR DOG IN THE CAR UNTIL WE ARE READY TO TRAIN.
PLEASE REMAIN IN THE CAR PARK UNTIL CLASS START TIME
ALL DOGS MUST BE BROUGHT INTO THE TRAINING ARENA ON A LEAD**

You will need:

- Food for training. Chop your food very small and carry in a plastic container with a sealed lid. If you are buying treats select small, moist varieties that can be swallowed without crunching or chewing.
- Toys – I recommend at least two of your dog's favourite ball or tug. I also recommend long handled tugs for safety. You may find a soft food dispensing toy useful e.g. The Clam
- Dress comfortably – you may be bending and will be moving around. I recommend flat walking shoes or trainers. In cold weather wear footwear with a good grip. You need a pocket for food or wear a treat bag. We will be working outside please dress for the weather.
- Pack a blanket, crate or raised bed for your dog to rest if you wish. Provide your dog with a coat if they need one.
- Water is available but bring your own bowl
- Pack spare poo bags – all waste must be taken away.

- Your dog needs a flat collar and a 6ft training lead – not flexi. If you do not have a training lead at this point do not worry, use a normal walking lead. Long line if you have concerns around recall.
- Some plastic chairs are provided but may be wet. If you will need a seat during the lesson, please let me know in advance and just in case pack an old towel or your own fold up chair.
- A notebook and pen, or electronic note taker

Please read the following carefully:

Foxhill dog training arena is private property which cannot be entered without permission.

The area around the arena is used by children and it is not appropriate to allow your dog to toilet, please use the area around the dog park carpark.

The agility equipment inside the arena is the property of Red Dog Agility, it must not be used without permission and dogs cannot toilet on the equipment.

Any accidents must be reported and cleaned up using the materials provided.
