



Hi! I'm Claire, resident artist at Krafty Kidz! Thanks for your interest in my classes. I really hope your child enjoys it. As a professional portrait artist with an MA in fine art, my ideas for my classes are based on teaching the fundamentals of drawing and will be perfectly suited to your child at Krafty Kidz

The children will have access to tough spots throughout the duration of the class. They will play with the resources when they enter the class and when they complete tasks. These activities range from lego, zoobs, playmobil, play dough, loose parts etc.

Please be aware that upon arrival at the venue you will need to climb one step to gain entry and that the toilets are not wheelchair accessible. At the end of the class, I shall open the door and invite you in to collect your child. This is so that I can ensure they are all leaving with an adult that they know.

A water bottle and any medication is all that is required. If your child has to bring a phone to class then I will keep it safe until the end of the class to ensure that it does not get damaged by the resources. Like they will have experience at school, the room will be well ventilated so it would be helpful if your child wore layers of clothing to ensure that they are not too hot or cold.

If your child is not comfortable with wearing an apron then please don't worry, but it would be a great idea to bring your child in old clothes as we all know that children have a knack for getting covered in things which stain.

As is expected at school, please do not bring your child to Krafty Kidz if they are unwell.
