Estate Yard Car Park

Vehicle Access to the Estate Office and Car Park is through the main gates to the park, off the westbound carriageway of the A4. The gates are between Hogarth roundabout and the junction of the A4 with Sutton Court Road.



On the A4 heading westwards from Hogarth roundabout look out for this sign and TAKE THIS TURNING. Head through the big, blue iron gates.

(IGNORE the fact that it says Service Vehicles only.
IGNORE the direction with the official blue car park symbol. This is the public car park.)

Proceed about halfway up the tree lined avenue. Then take the right turn into the Estate Yard, just after Paxton & Kent House. (see blue arrow overleaf).

Stop at the blue gates and press the buzzer on the entry phone on your right.

Please turn on your hazard lights and adhere to the 5mph speed limit, keeping a particular eye out for dogs off the lead and children.

PLEASE NOTE THAT WE ARE A PUBLIC PARK AND IT IS ESSENTIAL TO DRIVE VERY CAREFULLY AND BE VIGILANT AT ALL TIMES.

- Gates and Entrances:** Rustic House Gate, Dukes Avenue Gate, Corney Road Gate, Great Chertsey Road Gate, and Hogarth Gate.
- Paths and Roads:** A4 Great West Road, Paxton Road, Burlington Lane, Cornsey Road, and Grantham Road.
- Facilities and Amenities:** Parking (P), wheelchair access (wheelchair icon), and other facilities (cycling, picnic, etc.) are marked with icons.
- Other Features:** The Northern Wilderness, the Patte d'oie (goosefoot), the Underpass, and the Short Road.
