

Materials are available at Pastimes in King's Lynn and online (ArtDiscount, Cowling&Wilcox, Jackson's, Ken Bromley). Buy the individual pigment tubes rather than sets of paints. If you let me know before your course starts, I can supply a suitable alternative to a StayWet Palette for £13. If you chose to paint on canvas covered boards or canvas you will not need a painting board. There is room to put up a field easel if you prefer to use one (must have legs suitable for a wooden floor – no spikes, thank you.)

I use Winsor & Newton Galleria products for demonstrating. Using other brands is perfectly acceptable but do try to use only one brand to get consistent mixing.

Brushes – these are just suggestions as brush use is very individual. If you already have brushes, just bring what you already have.	Flat size 12, 4, 1; Round size 12, 4, 1; Rigger (you may have to buy a watercolour brush for this) size 2; 2 cm Fan brush.
