

September 2025 Class in the Post



This class uses the Autumn Toile Suite but you could complete it with any set. When following the cutting instructions bear in mind that if you have the class pack the die cuts are already done for you, so just cut the card bases.

Card 1: Double Z Accordion Card



Measurements:

Card Base: 14.8 cm x 17.5 cm

Score @ 3.5 cm & 7 cm

Coordinating Cardstock: 4 cm x 17.5 cm (3 pieces)

Score @ 3.5 cm & 7 cm

DSP:

- 3.5 x 10 cm (×3)
- 3.5 x 3 cm (×6)

Method:

Fold and burnish all the score lines

Stick the DSP to the three strips - see above

Stick the strips to the card base as shown below. NB stick the bottom and top strips on first in line with the top and bottom of the card base, then the middle one is easy to place.

Colour the leaf die cuts as you wish. I used ink and blending brushes

Colour the tree base die cut

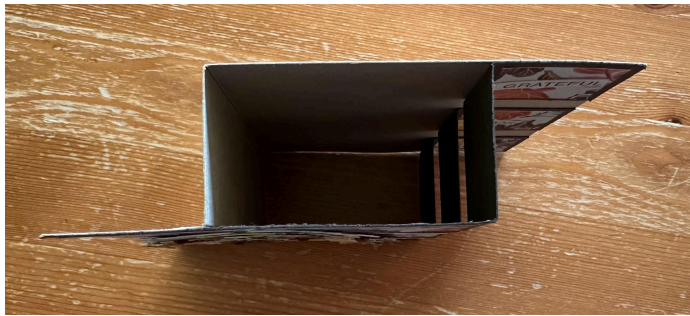
Stick the leaves to the tree, you may wish to break some apart

Stick the tree to the card - be careful where you put the glue due to the spacing between the strips.

I grounded the tree by adding a die cut (I cut the deer from the die cut and a bit of fussy cutting).

Stamp a sentiment and then cut it apart and arrange on the card - see above

Add gems.



Card 2: Die cut Leaves background card



Measurements:

Basic Beige Card Base 14.8 cm x 21 cm scored at 10.5 cm
Basic Beige layer 10.1 cm x 14.4 cm for leaves die cut from Amber Autumn
Scrap Early Espresso for deer die cut from Autumn Trees
Scrap Calypso Coral for die cut from Nested Essential Dies
Piece of Toile Designer Series Paper with full tree image

Method:

Fold and burnish the card base
Stick the leaves die cut to the card base
Fussy cut the tree from the DSP keeping some extra paper below the tree base to hide under the sentiment piece. I chose a tree with a deer beside it so I included it.
Stamp the sentiment to the right of the Calypso Coral die cut shape.
Assemble your pieces to make a scene with dimensionals
Stick the sentiment piece over the base of your scene with dimensionals at the bottom and glue at the top
Add a bow to the left of the sentiment
Add streaked dots.

Card 3: Large Stepper Card



Measurements: circle scenes card

Card base Crumb Cake 14.8 cm x 21 cm scored at 10.5 cm

Very Vanilla layer 10.1 cm x 14.4 cm - cut 2

DSP layer 9.7 cm x 14 cm

Punch or die cut 3 scenes from the Toile Paper - I used 2 3/8" (6 Cm) Circle Punch

3 circles of Early Espresso slightly larger than your scene circles - I used 2 1/4" (5.7 Cm) Circle Punch.

Method:

Colour the edge of the very vanilla layer using a blending brush with Early Espresso

Brush around the edge of the DSP layer without adding more ink to your brush.

Stick the DSP to the coloured very vanilla layer and then stick this to the card base

Stick the circle scenes to the Early Espresso circles

Arrange the circles and stick to the card base with dimensionals

Mask the words in the sentiment that you don't want with washi tape, ink up then remove the washi tape.

Stamp the word Grateful to the right of the Calypso Coral banner die cut.

Carefully cut the banner die cut in two and stick to card as shown above

Add streaked dots
