

Scallops and Gingham - July 2026 Class



Card One -



Measurements:

Card Base: Basic White Sheet Folded in half - use largest die to cut card base by placing the die slightly beyond the fold line

Barely Blush circle - largest Die

DSP cut 2 circles with the 2nd largest die

Method:

1. See video or attend zoom class for how to assemble this card
2. Stamp, colour and die cut or fussy cut some flowers and leaves- I used Boutique Blossoms
3. Stamp a sentiment on the scalloped rectangle die
4. Add the sentiment to the inside of the card with dimensionals so that it will hold the card in place when open.
5. Add the flowers and leaves to the card and decorate with the gold butterflies.

Card Two - Pop Up Card



Measurements:

Card Base: 14.8cm x 21 cm scored at 4.5 cm, 7.5 cm, 13.5 cm and 16.5 cm

DSP: 2 pieces 14.4 cm x 4.1 cm. 2 pieces 14.4 cm x 2.6 cm and 1 piece 14.4 cm x 5.6 cm

Method:

1. Die cut 4 nesting scalloped circles starting with the 2nd largest die- see picture above for order of card and DSP.
2. Stamp a sentiment on the smallest circle layer and add a flower with 2nd generation stamping
3. Stick the circles together as above.
4. Stick the DSP strips to the card base.
5. Fold and burnish the score lines and fold so that the middle section pops out.
6. Stick the circle topper to the middle section
7. Embellish to taste.

Card Three - Gingham Flowers



Measurements:

Card Base: Golden Glow 14.8 cm x 21 cm scored at 10.5 cm

2 Basic white layers: 14.4 cm x 10.1 cm

Method:

1. Emboss one of the white layers with your choice of folders (I used Stone & vine 3D)
2. Add spatter with a marker or shimmer pen to the embossed layer
3. Create a dark edge around this layer with a marker or an inkpad
4. Arrange the gingham 'flowers' to the embossed layer and stick them down
5. Add black centres to the flowers and scatter some leaves around.
6. Trim any overhanging flower petals to using the edge of the layer as a guide
7. Stick this to the front of the card
8. Stamp a sentiment on the small white die cut and stick to card
9. Embellish to taste.
