Card 1: Grunge Background Card



Measurements:

Crumb Cake card base: 29.6cm x 10.5cm

Score in half @ 14.8cm to make a tent fold card.

Early Espresso layer: 14.4cm x 10.1cm

DSP layer: 14cm x 9.7cm + 3cm x 9.7cm

White layer for inside: 14.4cm x 10.1cm

Scrap of Crumb Cake for sentiment

Instructions

- 1) Stamp on large DSP some foliage and texture stamps – I used Pecan Pie & Early Espresso.
- 2) Screw the DSP into a ball in your hands to distress it.
- 3) Flatten it out and swipe with Early Espresso ink pad to further distress it. Distress the edges with the edge of scissors or tearing. Roll a couple of corners..
- 4) Similarly distress the edges of the Early Espresso layer.
- 5) Stick the DSP layer to the Early Espresso layer and then onto the card base.
- 6) Stick the small DSP layer in the lower half of the card.
- 7) Decorate with the foliage die cut, a sentiment and the pentagons.

Card 2: Layered Card



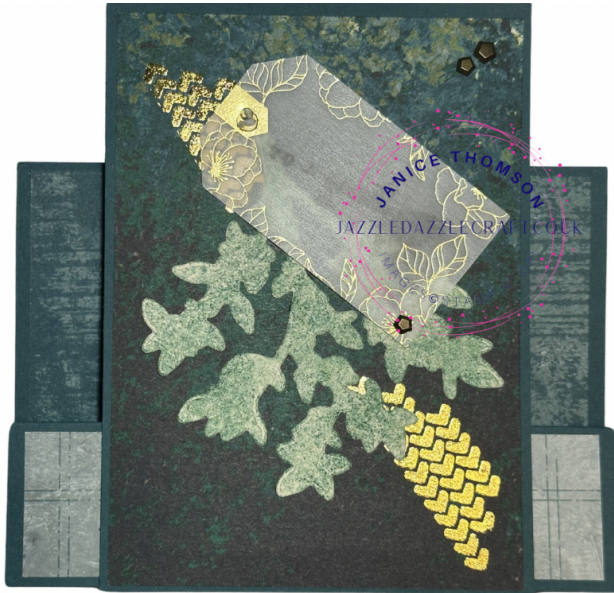
Measurements

1. Balmy Blue card base – 14.8cm x 21cm
2. Scored @ 10.5cm
3. Blueberry Bushel layer – 14.4cm x 10.1cm
4. Balmy Blue layer – 14cm x 9.7cm
5. DSP layer – 13.5 x 9cm
6. White layer for inside – 14.4cm x 10.1cm

Instructions

1. Die cut the large foliage shape from the balmy blue layer – towards the bottom right hand corner.
2. Stamp some texture onto the balmy blue layer & add some gold accents.
3. Add ink to the foliage die cut with scrunched up cling film.
4. Carefully glue the DSP behind the aperture.
5. Stick this to the blueberry bushel layer and then onto the card base.
6. Attach the die cut with dimensionals.
7. Decorate with ribbon, the texture die, small foliage die cuts, sentiment and pentagons.

Card 3: Faux Stepper Card



Measurements:

Card Base - 2 pieces of Pretty Peacock

1. 29 cm x 10.5 cm scored at 14.5 cm
2. 29 cm x 14.8 cm scored at 4 cm, 8 cm and 18.5 cm

DSP - 3 pieces

1. 14.1 cm x 10.1 cm (portrait)
2. 14.4 cm x 10.1 cm (landscape)
3. 14.4 cm x 3.5 cm (landscape)

Basic white layer for inside 10.1 cm x 14.4 cm

Very Vanilla for large foliage die cut

Method:

Concertina fold & burnish the largest piece of pretty peacock

Glue the DSP pieces to the card bases as in the picture

Attach the smaller piece of pretty peacock to the concertina piece as in the picture

Stamp a sentiment onto a vellum tag with Stazon or heat emboss it

Add ink texture to the die cut then stick it onto the card

Add gold accents, vellum tag and pentagons
