

Going Round in Circles class in the post

Card One: Circle Flap Card



Measurements

Night of Navy card base is 5 ½" x 7 ¼" score at 3 inches or 17.5 cm x 14.8 cm score at 7 cm

Night of Navy Circle is approximately 4 inches in diameter or 10 cm

The basic white circle is approximately 3 ½" diameter or 9 cm

one piece of basic white 5 ¼" x 4" or 10.1 cm x 14.4 cm

one piece of basic white 2 ¾" by 5 ¼" or 6.6 x 14.4 cm

one piece of designer series paper 2 ½" x 5" or 6.2 cm x 14 cm

Instructions

1. Watch the video for clarity.
2. Score a ½" or 1cm flap on the side of the Night of Navy Circle
3. Stamp on the DSP and the White circle
4. Layer the white circle onto the Night of Navy circle and trim the side edge inline with the score
5. Stamp on the DSP if you want to and layer that onto the white strip stick this to the front of the card
6. Stick the circle to the side of the card using the flap you scored
7. Stick the basic white piece inside the card covering the flap on the circle.
8. Decorate as you wish.

Going Round in Circles class in the post

Card Two: Circle Easel Card



Measurements:

The base card is made using the largest deckled circle die approximately 5 ¾" in diameter

Fold a full sheet of Boho Blue card in half and cut the circle slightly over the fold

1 Boho Blue circle 5 ¾" diameter 14.5 cm

2 basic white circles approximately 5 ¼" in diameter 13.5 cm

1 misty moonlight circle approximately 5 ¼" in diameter 13.5 cm

1 circle of designer series paper approximately 5" in diameter 12.5 cm

scraps of each colour for the sentiment.

Instructions:

Stamp a scene on the Designer Series Paper Circle

Stick this onto the Misty Moonlight Circle and then onto the Boho Blue Circle (this is now your topper)

Fold the top half of the card base in half

Cut 1 of the basic white circles in half and stick on the inside top of the card

Stick the full basic white circle inside the bottom of the card

Close the base card flat and stick the topper onto it only adding glue to the bottom half so that you can still form the easel.

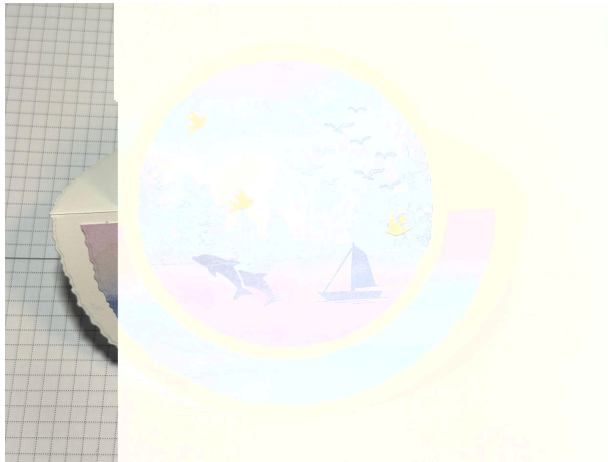
Using the scraps, stamp a sentiment and layer up then add to the open card with dimensionals, or the foam in your kit, to form a stopper for the open card.

I stamped this card with Delicate Forest and Fields of Bloom. The sentiment is from Magnolia Mood. All in the 24 -25 Annual Catalogue.

card three: Rocker card.



Stamp on the DSP circle to make a scene
Stick this to the slightly larger White circle.
Stick this to the base card.
Decorate to taste.

I stamped with Under the Moon and Beside
Me stamp sets from the Current Annual
Catalogue.

Measurements:

One basic white circle using the largest die
which is 5 $\frac{3}{4}$ " in diameter or 14.5 cm

one basic white circle approximately 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ "
inches or 10 cm

designer series paper half of a 5 inch circle or
12.5 cm circle

and a DSP 4" circle or 9 cm

Instructions

Fold the largest white circle in half to form
the card base.

Stick the half circle to this

Card Four - Split Circle Card



Measurements

Basic white card base

3 designer series paper circles:

one at 2 $\frac{3}{8}$ " or 6 cm

one at 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " or 4 cm

one at $\frac{3}{4}$ " or 2 cm

Pretty Peacock Layer 5" x 3 $\frac{1}{4}$ inches or
12.8 cm x 8.6 cm

Basic white layer 4 $\frac{3}{4}$ " x 3" or 11.8 cm x 7.6
cm

A strip of basic white 1.5 cm x 11.8 cm or 4 $\frac{3}{4}$ "
x $\frac{3}{4}$ ".

Instructions

Cut all three circles in half

Layer and stick them on top of each other as
above

Stick them on the white layer, leaving an
open space between them

Stamp sentiment on the white strip and stick
over the space between the half circles

Stick this layer to the pretty peacock layer
and then onto the card base

Add any embellishments that you wish to
