On arrival, please report to reception where you will be met by a member of our staff to escort you to the training room. To access main reception please use the pedestrian entrance adjacent to the main vehicle entrance.

Parking

There may be possible free parking however it is the trainee's responsibility to check any parking restrictions/signs before leaving their vehicles.

Possible parking options:

What3Words addresses provided below put you at start of, or close to, where parking starts. There is paid parking closer to venue but generally is a maximum of 2hrs or half day stay. You can pay to park at the venue but this is limited to a maximum of half day.

It should be a 5-10mins walk to the venue from parking. Please be aware that roads closer to Morden are permit only/short stay paid parking during the day due to people using the Northern Line tube.

Directions

The Grange is prominently located on the main junction of the A297 St Helier Avenue and the A239 Morden Road. Diagonally opposite Morden Hall Park and it's idyllic grounds where the Phipps Bridge tram stop can be found offering a direct route into either central Croydon to the southeast, or Wimbledon town centre to the northwest.

The A297 eventually merges into the A24 so offers a direct route into central London to the north or the M25 & M23 to the south. The M23 in turn provides a direct route to Gatwick Airport.

Morden town centre with its tube station is within a 10 minutes' walk of the building. The tube station is on the Northern Line and offers a direct route into the city of London as well as Clapham Junction and London Waterloo.
