6. This is the Entrance

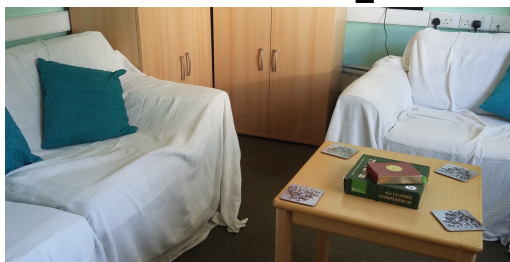

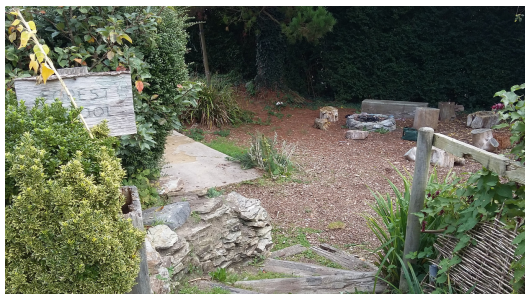

Our Projects 

- **Rooted clubs:** For children and young people with Autism, ADHD, but are inclusive.
- **Sense Aware:** Help children take ownership of their behavior and emotions in sensory based activities.
- **Adventure breaks:** For children with disabilities to engage in adventure activities such as moor walking and canoeing.
- **Inclusion Brokerage:** Supporting families with disabled children.
- **Short breaks:** Activities during school holidays for children with a diagnosis, Autism etc.
- **In Other Words:** Group for children and young people with mental health issues.
- **Children's Minds Families Matter:** Support for parents/families who have children with mental health issues.
- **Beckly Play Scheme:** Weekend and school holiday sessions for children with disabilities and high-level needs.
- **Radford Rascals:** After school club for 5 - 8 year old children with disabilities.
- **Little Seeds:** Parent and toddler group.
- **Personal mentor network:** Support for 18 - 24 year olds to get into work.
- **Victim care:** Cope and recover work with victims of crime.
- **Duke of Edinburgh Awards,** supporting community groups and special schools.
- **Outdoor Education Service,** Supporting schools with outdoor education and school trips.
