ATPL Theory Programme

APSMCC

CAE's Airline Pilot Standard Multi-Crew Cooperation (APS MCC) course has been designed to train single seat pilots in the team skills necessary for the safe operation of complex, multi-crew, jet aircraft. During the course, you will be introduced to the competencies necessary for this demanding transition. The training will take place throughout all phases of flight under normal, abnormal and emergency conditions. The course is offered in both London Gatwick (A320 FFS & FTD - UK CAA only) and in Amsterdam (B737NG FTD- EASA only). Candidates must have completed ATPL Theory, CPL and MEIR prior to starting the APS MCC course.

ATPL Brush Up Session

CAE's ATPL Brush Up Session is designed for cadets who seek to build confidence and enhance their piloting skills. The programme is held over a two-day period at CAE's London-Gatwick Training Center, covering Meteorology, Principles of Flight, General Navigation and Flight Planning. Candidates must be currently enrolled in an ATPL theory course, whether that be full time or distance learning, and will take their exams under their current ATO.

Type Rating Programmes

CAE offers pilots one of the industry's most advanced and comprehensive type rating training programmes. Our programme combines innovative methodologies, knowledgeable instructors and advanced simulation technology for a truly unique learning experience. License Proficiency Check
