About the Event

Join us for an FCI-Style simulator competition – an authentic experience designed to mirror international agility competition formats. Run on AWC-style courses created by 2027 EO and AWC judges and judged by top UK judges.

This event is perfect for handlers aiming for Team GB tryouts, or anyone looking to experience the challenge and thrill of continental style agility.

Competition Format

Each competitor will run:

1 x Agility Course

1 x Jumping Course

1 x Agility Final (based on combined results from previous rounds)

Courses will follow FCI rules with appropriate heights, time faults and judging criteria.

Eligibility

Open to experienced agility handlers and competing dogs, aimed at handlers with dogs competing at higher levels.

Entry Fees

£25 per dog for the full simulator (Agility + Jumping + Final)

Prizes

First place rosettes awarded to the winner of each round.

Rules

Run under FCI-style rules: no collars, the judge will start you on a whistle, 15 second countdown.

Indoor arena with astro surface

Running Orders

For each round, we will start with Large and work down through the heights.

Please be prepared and ready for your run when called.

THE VENUE

Classes will take place in one indoor ring on juta astro turf.

Clean flat shoes must be worn indoors. Please leave dirty footwear at the door.

There is a £10 charge for any toileting inside the venue that must be paid immediately.

Dogs must be clean and have dry feet.

Please ensure you fully read the arena rules before attending

VENUE RULES

All attendees are expected to conduct themselves in a respectful and orderly manner. Any disruptive behaviour will result in removal from the premises.

Attendees participate at their own risk. Base Agility, Agility BASE and Brinsea Green Farm are not liable for any injury, loss or damage suffered by attendees.

Each attendee is responsible for their own safety and agrees to indemnify Agility BASE against any legal claims or actions resulting from accidents, injuries, or losses incurred during their use of the facility.

Children must be supervised by a parent or guardian at all times while on the premises. This is a working farm.

CCTV is in operation within the arena throughout the entire farm for your safety.

Please drive slowly and cautiously through the farm to ensure the safety of all visitors, animals and property.

Please be considerate of neighbouring properties and respect any livestock.

Please park responsibly, ensuring that no roadways or gateways are obstructed at any time.

Dogs must be kept on lead at all times except when actively engaged in working whilst indoors or in the designated outdoor exercise area.

Dogs must be clean and have dry feet when on the astro turf. Make sure you have a towel.

Ensure your dog is toileted regularly outside before entering the arena. Toileting indoors is strictly prohibited. If your dog has an accident, you must stop immediately, clean the area right away. **A £10 fine will be applied for indoor accidents.**

Toys must be clean, and treats should not crumble.

Please ensure you wear clean, flat shoes – stud type soles and trail shoes are not permitted. Please have separate shoes for outdoor use. Leave dirty footwear at the door, checks will be in place.

No food or drink is permitted outside of the viewing area.

Smoking and vaping is strictly prohibited indoors. Please be considerate of others when smoking or vaping outdoors and ensure that doorways remain clear.

DIRECTIONS

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COMING FROM M5 Junction 21

Take the A370 towards Congresbury. At the traffic lights by The Congresbury Arms, take the B3133 signposted for Churchill and Cheddar. Just after 1 mile, when you see signs on your left for Leonard Elms Care Home turn right into Brinsea Lane.**

COMING FROM A38

In Langford, turn off the A38 by Tout's ESSO Garage onto the B3133, signposted for Clevedon, Congresbury, Lower Langford and Langford Veterinary Services.

At the mini roundabout turn left signed Congresbury and Clevedon.

Pass Milton's Hotel Cottages on your left, and take the next turning (about half a mile) on your left into Brinsea Lane.**

**Head up Brinsea Lane, when you reach the triangle, keep to the left. There are signs for B&B and Brinsea Green Farm.

Follow the lane, past the bungalow and into the farmyard. Bear left, go through the gates and follow the signs for Agility Base and then for the car park.

Please drive with care along Brinsea Lane to be respectful of our neighbours. Brinsea Green Farm is a working farm. Please drive slowly and carefully through the farmyard. Be aware of people, animals and moving machinery.
