



## FAQs

### **Are there ID requirements or an age limit to enter the event?**

All attendees must be 16 or over, except for Child & Parent cooking classes or where accompanied by a responsible adult.

### **What are my transport/parking options for getting to the event?**

Paid Parking is available in nearby streets. The nearest station is Lewisham, served by National Rail and DLR. A member of our team will be present at the main gate to meet and greet before start times.

### **What should I wear and bring with me?**

Please wear comfortable clothes and shoes as there may be a lot of standing in your session. The room can get quite hot, so please bear this in mind. For food hygiene reasons, please tie long hair back. We provide aprons, although you may bring your own if you're more comfortable with that. Equipment is provided. We are committed to environmental sustainability. Please bring your own containers to take your food home, where possible. More information is provided in your pre-class instructions.

Prices do not include special gifts and entertainment unless offered as part of a package. If a non-Greenwich Pantry venue is requested for the class, a charge will be included in the package.

**Attendance requirements:** We welcome everyone to our classes; however, when children are attending, they must be at least 7 years old for classes. Under 7s must be accompanied by a responsible adult.

An additional payment will be requested for adults attending with a child (£30.00) for a birthday cooking class.
