

If you are unsure of how to rig a certain boat please contact the Sailing Manager sailing@pooleyc.co.uk who will be able to help set up a lesson for you.

Fusion

This is a single or double handed boat.

Masts are located on the side of the Oppy Shed, please ensure that you match the Mast Number to Boat Number.

Jibs & Spinnakers are located on the back wall, inside the Oppy Shed.

Boats can be launched from the Beach or the Slipway.

Hartley 15s

This is a double handed boat and can be sailed with a max of 4 people.

All sails are kept in the boats.

The spinnaker may not be rigged, these can be found in the Oppy Shed if needed.

Boats can be launched from the Beach or the Slipway.

GP14

This is a double handed race boat.

Must contact James Stafford or Barry Southam for a lesson on rigging etc before first use.

Oppy

This is a child's single-handed boat.

Masts (and booms, sprits and Sails) and Foils can be found in the Oppy Shed, please note that all kit must be kept with the appropriate boat (all named).

Boats can be launched from the Beach or the Slipway.

Children must always be supervised whilst using the kit.

Stand-Up-Paddleboard

Padlock Keys and Paddles are located in the Bar, you will need to sign this kit out.

Boards can ONLY be launched from the Beach

Rigiflex's

Rigiflex Boat Numbers are: 5 & 9 (these are the two that have prop guards fitted)

Padlock Keys and kill cords are in the Sailing Office lock box. Safety Bags are also located in this office.

Must hold a valid PB2 License.

Rigiflex's must only be used to support the safety of a sailor.

RIGIFLEX'S MUST NOT BE USED FOR JOYRIDING OR SOCIAL TRIPS

ALL BOATS MUST BE RETURNED TO THE SAME LOCATION, AND ANY ISSUES MUST BE REPORTED AS SOON AS POSSIBLE TO THE SAILING MANAGER: sailing@pooleyc.co.uk
