



RULES OF PLAY

Please take a look at Little tinkers rules of play

- Children must be accompanied at all times by a responsible adult. Parents/guardians are responsible for their children, their behaviour and wellbeing and are NOT permitted to leave them unattended. Destructive, or disruptive behaviour will not be tolerated. The management reserve the right to remove anyone behaving in an unacceptable manner.
- Children may only use the facilities if accompanied by an adult. This includes whist using the bathroom.
- Shoes must be removed before entering the play area and socks must be worn at all times by children and adults.
- Any loose items (e.g. car keys and money) must be removed before entering the play area. If glasses are worn particular care should be taken.
- We do not take responsibility for any personal items lost or damaged within the play area.
- No food or drink is to be taken into the play area at any point.
- No smoking, e-cigarette or chewing gum on the premises.

Supervision

Children must be supervised at all times by the parent or responsible adult accompanying them. The children's act of 1989 requires us to inform you of this obligation. Little tinkers does not accept responsibility for child supervision whilst on our premises or using the equipment. Our staff are not available to supervise you children. This is not our obligation.

Accidents

It is a condition of entry that any accident is reported to a member of staff and recorded in the accident book. It is important to follow the safety rules when using the equipment.

Liability

Little tinkers does not accept responsibility or liability for loss or injury or whatever nature caused through misuse of equipment or lack of supervision by a parent or accompanying responsible adult.

- The management reserve the right to refuse entry.
- All age restrictions imposed by the management must be adhered to.
- Children who are unwell should not use the equipment.
- All children and additional adults will be charged an entrance fee.
- Little tinkers can not be held responsible for accidents which occur as a result of playing on the apparatus.
- Inappropriate or offensive language is not permitted.
