Course Overview: RYA VHF/SRC Radio Course (**ONLINE**)

The Online RYA VHF/SRC course is for anyone who owns a fixed or handheld marine VHF radio. The optional in person exam afterwards enables the person completing the exam successful to be issued with an SRC (Short Range Certificate) Operators license.

Minimum age: 16+

Course Structure

Online Course + an in person exam:

- **Online self-paced study** – 6 - 8 hours
- **Exam** (Optional*) - approx. 1 - 2 hours

*you can attend the SRC Course without choosing to sit the exam. However, please note you will not be issued with an SRC Licence.
