<b>Record Status</b>	UK Record Status
<b>Novice Archers</b>	A Novice Archer is an archer that has been an Archery GB member for less than 2 years at the date of the tournament. <b>Novice Junior Archers will be in a separate category to adults</b>
<b>Rounds</b>	<b>900 Rounds: 30 arrows per distance on a 122cm target face.</b>  <b>Novice archers and novice junior archers should select a round that is comfortable but still challenging.</b>  900 70: 70m/60m/50m WA900: 60m/50m/40m 900 50: 50m/40m/30m 900 40: 40m/30m/20m 900 30: 30m/20m/10m  <b>Experienced junior archers will be awarded as per the following age categories:</b>  900 70: 70m/60m/50m – Under 21 WA900: 60m/50m/40m – Under 18 900 50: 50m/40m/30m – Under 16 & Under 15 900 40: 40m/30m/20m – Under 14 900 30: 30m/20m/10m – Under 12
<b>Venue</b>	Down Yonder, Old Bromley Heath Road, Hambrook, Bristol BS16 6JA  Note: Cleve Archers is situated next to a no through road. You must approach from the Avon Ring Road A4174 along Bromley Heath Road to avoid a 20 minute detour.

<b>Registration &amp; Shooting Times</b>	<b>Registration from 9:00am</b> <b>Equipment Inspection from 9:30am</b> <b>Assembly at 10:00am, immediately followed by practice.</b>
<b>Shooting Details</b>	There will be up to four archers per boss, in two details, using foam bosses on H frames. All distances will be shot in ends of 6 arrows, in 4 minutes, at 122cm target faces. All archers will have up to 30 minutes of practice at distance 1 only. You may shoot as many arrows as you like during the 4 minutes during practice. All disciplines controlled by lights.
<b>Age Categories</b>	<i>308 (b) (i) An archer may compete in a junior age group where the tournament take place up to and in the year of their birthday prior to the limit on the category. (e.g., if they turned 17 in a year, they can compete in an U18 category, but they cannot turn 18 in the year)</i>

<b>Awards</b>	<p>Medals for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> places in all categories</p> <p>Archers may enter rounds above their age group if desired and will be eligible for awards. Archers may also enter rounds below their age group but will not be eligible for awards.</p>
<b>Entry Fee</b>	<b>£15</b>
<b>Closing Date</b>	8 <sup>th</sup> May 2026 or when the tournament is full – No entries will be accepted after the closing date. There will be no refunds after this date.

<b>Drug Testing</b>	Record Status Shoots are liable for Drug testing. Any competitors approached to give samples MUST comply. If they refuse, that refusal will be treated as a positive result. Parents/Guardians must give consent for under 18s to be drug tested if approached.
<b>Archery GB Membership</b>	Entrants must declare their Archery GB membership number when entering and membership cards must be shown when registering on the day. Failure to do so will result in you not being allowed to shoot.
<b>Photography</b>	In line with the recommendation in the AGB Safeguarding Policy, those who wish to take photographs or video at this event are to register with the Tournament Organiser on arrival. Unauthorised photography is not permitted. Photos and videos taken at this event may be used by Cleve Archers across its communication channels to promote the sport. If you are concerned about any photography and videos taking place at this event, or do not wish to be photographed please contact the tournament organiser directly.
<b>Dress Regulation Rule 307</b>	For record status events there are dress regulations in place that have to be followed by all competitors. These are set out in the Archery GB Rules of Shooting. Any archer not complying with these regulations may not be permitted to shoot.
<b>Disclaimer</b>	Cleve Archers or their members cannot take any responsibility for injury or any loss from, or damage to, any vehicle or equipment howsoever caused. Entry to the tournament will be taken as acceptance of these conditions.
<b>General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR)</b>	When you enter competitions the following information may be collected and shared with Tournament Organisers, scoring systems and other competitors. For example target lists and results may be published: First Name, Surname, Gender, Bow Style, Archery GB number, Age Category, Club, Round, Disabled (Y/N). Juniors Date of Birth is only used for selecting / checking correct round shot. Contact information such as email, addresses & phone numbers will not be published and only available to the Tournament Organiser to enable them to contact the archer if required to do so. The information supplied will be held no longer than two years after the event to enable the tournament organiser to send Results from that year, contact you the following year with the event information or for the return of any trophies won.
