

# BHS Terms and Conditions

## BHS Stage 4 and Performance Coach Training



### General

- Online entries only.
- Everyone attending the training is responsible for ensuring the safety of themselves and others.
- The BHS and the venue cannot provide supervision for attendees under the age of 18.
- Any attendee below the age of 16 years should be accompanied by a responsible adult who remains at the venue for the duration of the clinic.
- Attendees aged 16-17, or an adult at risk, it is at the discretion of their parent or guardian as to whether they are supervised or not.
- Please follow the instructions of the event organiser, coach, or presenter at all times.
- Dogs are NOT permitted unless they are essential support dogs.
- Please dress according to weather conditions on the day.
- If you do not wish to be photographed or filmed, please inform the organiser.

### Cancellations

- This British Horse Society training will be checked for viability around fourteen working days beforehand. If there are insufficient numbers, the training may be cancelled. In this case, delegates who have booked will receive a full refund or free transfer should another suitable event be pending.
