



Terms and Conditions for After School Clubs

1. Enrolment and Registration

- Participants must complete the registration process to enrol in the holiday nature club.
- All information provided during registration must be accurate and up-to-date.
- Registration is on a first-come, first-served basis, and enrolment is confirmed upon receipt of payment.

2. Age and Eligibility:

- The holiday nature club is open to children within the specified age range.
- Participants must meet the eligibility criteria outlined for each program.

3. Code of Conduct:

- Participants are expected to adhere to a positive and respectful code of conduct.
- Disruptive behaviour that negatively impacts the experience of others may result in the participant being asked to leave without a refund.

4. Health and Medical Information:

- Parents/guardians must provide accurate health and medical information during registration, including any allergies or medical conditions.
- In case of a medical emergency, we will make every effort to contact parents/guardians. However, we reserve the right to seek necessary medical attention for the participant.

5. Emergency Contact:

- A valid emergency contact number must be provided during registration.
- Parents/guardians are responsible for updating emergency contact information as needed.

6. Photography and Media Consent:

- When enrolling your child in the holiday nature club, parents/guardians will be asked for permission for their child to be photographed or filmed for promotional purposes. Permission can be refused.
- Any concerns regarding media usage should be communicated in writing before the start of the program.

7. Payment and Refund Policy:

- Payment must be made in full to secure a spot in the holiday nature club.
- Refer to the cancellation policy for details on refunds due to cancellations by either the participant or the club.

8. Weather Conditions:

- The holiday nature club takes place in various weather conditions, as long as it is safe. Please refer to the cancellation policy for details regarding weather-related cancellations.

9. Changes to Program:

- The holiday nature club reserves the right to make changes to the program schedule, activities, or locations if necessary. Participants will be notified in advance whenever possible.

10. Assumption of Risk:

- Participation in outdoor activities carries inherent risks. Parents/guardians acknowledge and accept these risks when enrolling their child in the holiday nature club.

11. Communications:

- All communication regarding the holiday nature club will be primarily conducted through the email address provided during registration. It is the responsibility of parents/guardians to check their email regularly for updates.
