

Little Explorers Terms and Conditions

1. Nature Club Activities:

2. Inherent Risks:

- Participants acknowledge that outdoor activities inherently carry certain risks, including but not limited to rough terrain, weather changes, encounters with wildlife, and other unpredictable factors. By participating in our nature club activities, you accept these inherent risks.

3. Embracing Risky Play:

- Our nature club embraces the Forest School ethos, which encourages risky play as a means of promoting exploration, confidence, and resilience in natural environments. We believe that engaging in activities such as climbing trees, balancing on logs, and exploring natural features contributes to the holistic development of participants.

4. Participant Responsibilities:

- Carers and guardians are responsible for the safety and well-being of the children they are accompanying and themselves during nature club activities. It is important to exercise caution, follow instructions from club leaders, and respect the natural environment and its inhabitants.
- Parents or guardians are responsible for supervising their children at all times during club activities.
- To ensure the safety and quality of the experience for all participants, we maintain a child-to-adult ratio of no more than three children per one adult. This ratio helps ensure adequate supervision and attention for each child, promoting a safe and enjoyable environment for all.

5. Health and Medical Considerations:

- Participants are encouraged to assess their own health and physical fitness before participating in nature club activities. Please inform club leaders of any medical conditions, allergies, or special considerations that may affect your participation.

- In the event of a medical emergency, club leaders will take necessary steps to seek assistance and provide aid. However, participants understand that outdoor locations may have limited access to immediate medical care.
- Participants who are feeling unwell, exhibiting symptoms of illness, or have recently been in close contact with someone diagnosed with a contagious illness are kindly requested to refrain from attending nature club activities. This precaution is essential to safeguard the health and well-being of all participants.
- In the event of feeling unwell during a nature club activity, participants are encouraged to promptly notify club leaders and remove themselves from the group to minimize the risk of spreading illness.
- Participants who are unable to attend nature club activities due to illness or related concerns are requested to inform club leaders as soon as possible to facilitate any necessary adjustments or arrangements.

6. Photography and Media:

- When enrolling your child in the holiday nature club, parents/guardians will be asked for permission for their child to be photographed or filmed for promotional purposes. Permission can be refused.
- Any concerns regarding media usage should be communicated in writing before the start of the program.

7. Code of Conduct:

- All participants are expected to conduct themselves in a respectful and considerate manner towards fellow participants, club leaders, and the natural environment. Any behaviour that endangers the safety or well-being of others or disrupts the enjoyment of nature club activities may result in removal from the club.

8. Cancellation and Refunds:

- Nature club activities may be subject to cancellation or rescheduling due to inclement weather or unforeseen circumstances. In such cases, every effort will be made to notify participants in advance, and refunds or alternative arrangements may be offered where applicable.

9. Agreement to Terms:

- By participating in nature club activities, you acknowledge that you have read, understood, and agree to abide by these terms and conditions. Failure to comply with these terms may result in the termination of your participation in nature club activities.
