



The Big Bike Revival 2025 prize draw terms & conditions

The prize draw is run by Cycling UK. By submitting your entry to the prize draw you are agreeing to the following terms and conditions.

Eligibility

The prize draw is open to all The Big Bike Revival participants aged 18 or over. Cycling UK staff, their family members or anyone else connected with the prize draw are excluded from the draw. Grant recipients, their team members, and anyone employed or recruited in a paid or voluntary capacity to deliver the programme are also excluded from the draw. Only one entry per Big Bike Revival participant is permitted. Joint entries are not allowed. To ensure we meet the programme aims, Cycling UK retains the right to include any participant who would reasonably benefit from the prize draw and exclude anyone else. This exclusion covers, but is not limited to, any person who cycles once a month or more, owns a bike or are in a socio-economic position to purchase their own equipment or pay for any cycle or maintenance coaching or training courses

How to enter

To enter the prize draw, simply complete the first survey sent to you by Cycling UK after attending a Big Bike Revival event and a second one three months later. At the beginning of the second survey, you will have to indicate that you have read the prize draw terms and conditions and would like to take part in the draw.

You will have to complete both surveys to get the opportunity to enter to the prize draw. Those who complete the survey before **23:59 on 31st January 2026** will have the opportunity to enter the Prize draw that was open for entry from **2nd May 2025**. Entries received after the closing date will not be included in the prize draw.

Prizes

The prizes will be an adult bike worth up to £500 and four £100 High Street vouchers. The prizes are non-exchangeable, non-transferable and no cash alternatives will be offered.

Winners

The winner(s) will be selected by a random draw of entries received in accordance with these terms and conditions. The draw will be performed by a random computer process or otherwise supervised by an independent person shortly after the closing date. The winner will be notified via the email that was provided to Cycling UK. Cycling UK will attempt to contact the winner by email up to two times. If the winner does not respond to the emails notifying them of their win within 14 days of the second email, they will lose their right to the prize and Cycling UK reserves the right to choose and notify another winner. Our decision is final and binding as we will not enter into any correspondence about it.



Receipt of the prize

Please allow 30 days for delivery of the prize or alternative collection or delivery arrangements may be made through a mutual agreement.

Data protection and publicity

You consent to any personal information you provide in entering the prize draw being used by Cycling UK for the purposes of administering the prize draw in line with our [privacy and data protection policy](#). As part of accepting the prize, the winner agrees to take part in reasonable publicity related to The Big Bike Revival. This includes **having their first name, town or local area, and a photo shared by Cycling UK** in promotional materials such as social media, our website, and reports to funders. We may also get in touch to create a short feature or quote about your experience to help inspire others to get involved. By entering the draw, you're agreeing to this as a condition of winning.
