



School holiday club Welcome Pack

"We recognize that children need to be able to take risks in order to learn and develop. Coming home dirty, with a few bruises and scrapes are all part of a healthy childhood."

What will we be doing?

Forest school is a wonderful ethos brought over to the UK from Scandinavia, it allows children time and space to reconnect with nature in their own way. We offers lots of different activities each day, such as lighting fires, using tools, building dens, making crafts, creating dens, campfire cooking and so much more. However children on our holiday clubs are allowed to flow freely around the woods and dip in and out of activities at their own pace, it is a relaxed and wonderful environment where they will learn new skills and develop their self confidence in a way that is personal to each and every child.

What should your child bring?

During the winter months:

- Gloves and hat
- Jacket/ waterproof coat + trousers if possible
- Fleece/ jumper
- Warm socks and spare socks
- Warm wellies/ walking boots/ sturdy shoes (please note unless wellies are neoprene they're not very warm when they're wore all day)
- A complete spare set of clothes (+ bag to keep them in)

During the summer months:

- Sun hat and sun screen
- A thin, long sleeved top
- Long sleeved jumper
- Trousers
- Sturdy shoes/ walking boots
- A spare pair of trousers and socks (+ bag to keep them in)
- A waterproof coat (can be lightweight one if light showers are predicted)



The sessions will continue regardless of the weather unless specific risks are identified i.e. high winds, very low temperatures and floods. Please ensure that children are dressed appropriately and remember, there's no such thing as bad weather just the wrong clothing.

Children will need to bring with them a packed lunch and drink, they will be provided with a small snack and water will be available to top up drinks bottles throughout the day. We encourage food awareness and therefore discourage the bringing of energy or fizzy drinks. Please ensure that we are aware of any dietary information about your child.

We provide all the tools and equipment; please do not allow your child to bring any with them. If tools or dangerous equipment is brought from home it will be confiscated and locked away until the end of the session.

We do try to repatriate property at the end of the day, however we cannot take responsibility for belongings. We do not offer replacements or compensation for lost items. Please discourage the bringing of any valuable or well-loved items.

Where do we meet?

Our site is based at Betteshanger Park, we meet at the Visitor Centre / Cafe at the beginning of the day and children are then picked up from the same place. As you drive into the Park, take the first left into the car park, walk over to the Cafe and we will be waiting for you.

Please be aware that Betteshanger Park allows a free 20-minute drop off, after which time you will have to pay for parking. Unless you wish to pay for parking, please do not come earlier than the drop of and pick up times. We are unable to cancel any parking fines for exceeding the 20 minute free drop off period.

Getting there

By Road - We are well connected to the motorways (M20 and M2) and local road network, so we're easy to find. We are on the A258, approximately 2 miles from Deal and 10 miles from Dover. If you're using a Sat Nav, please use postcode CT14 OBF. Please be aware, your Sat Nav may take you along small country lanes. For a more direct route from the M20 or A2/M2, follow the A256 to Sandwich and then pick up the A258. Please do not follow road signs to Betteshanger village.

By Rail - We are well serviced by the main rail networks and Southeastern High Speed from London. Our nearest train stations are Deal (3 miles) or Sandwich (4 miles). For train times and rail enquiries please see Southeastern.

By Bus - Our local bus provider is Stagecoach and the No. 14 stops close to the Park. For bus times and enquires please see Stagecoach.
