

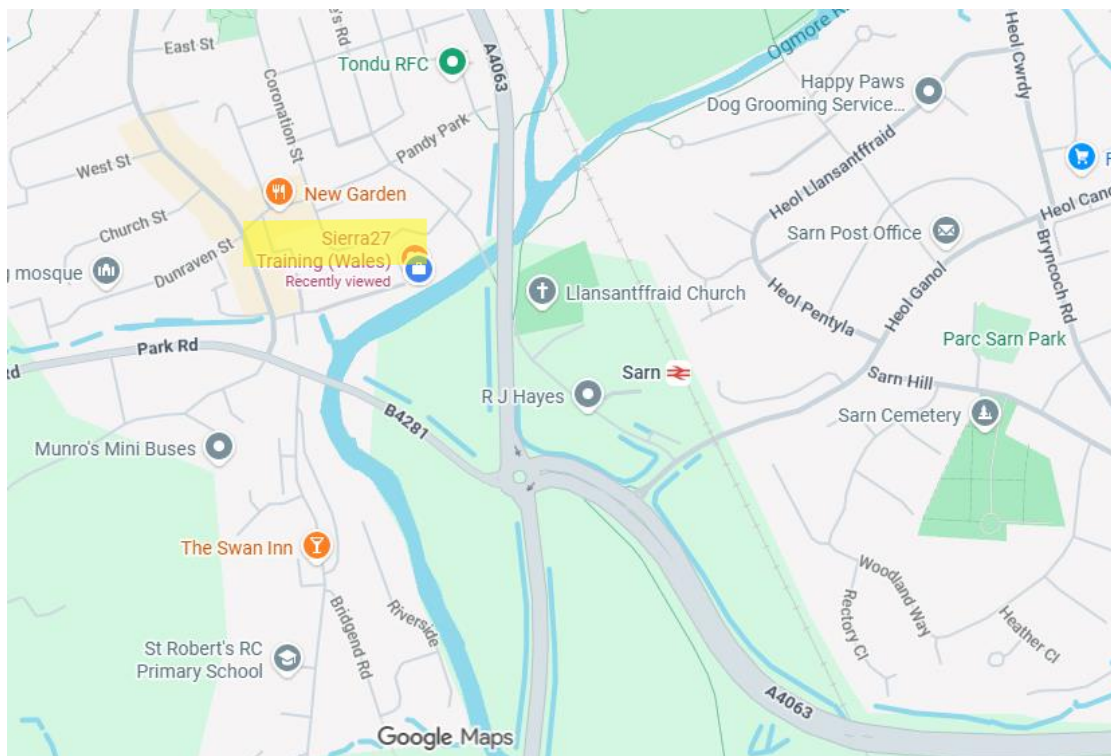


## SIERRA27 – Course Key Information

### Level 3 Award First Aid at Work & Paediatric First Aid

#### Venue & Transport

- **Location:** Apollo Business Village, Aberkenfig, Bridgend CF32 9RF
- **Parking:** Available on site
- **Public Transport:** Sarn train station (7-minute walk), nearby bus stops

## Course Schedule & Format

- **Duration:** 3 day – approximately 22 hours
- **Daily Timings:** 09:30 start, 17:00 finish
- **Attendance:** Mandatory for all sessions; no exceptions for late arrival or early departure
- **Delivery:** The course is delivered by use of PowerPoint presentation, Class discussion. Delivery would normally be within a classroom setting; however, this may be adjusted in accordance with learners' needs and/or local circumstances. Learners may be asked do some pre-course reading and therefore an hour of self-study and preparation has been added.

## The Course Topics Include:

- Roles and responsibilities of both first aiders and paediatric first aiders
- CPR and defibrillation
- Managing an unresponsive casualty
- Choking
- Burns and scalds.
- Wounds, bleeding, and shock
- Broken bones, fractures, and dislocations
- Meningitis
- Asthma
- Seizures and Epilepsy
- Febrile convulsions
- Anaphylaxis and Allergic reaction
- Minor injuries

## Qualification & Entry Requirements

- **Objective:** The objective of the qualification is to support learners in becoming emergency first aiders in the workplace. The content of the qualification meets the Health and Safety Executive (HSE) requirements for training emergency first-aiders in those organisations that have identified that staff need to be trained to this level within their first-aid needs assessment.
- **Qualification overview:** This specially designed course combines the Quallsafe Level 3 Award in First Aid at Work (RQF) and the Quallsafe Level 3 Award in Paediatric First Aid (RQF) into three extended days of classroom learning, minimising the number of training days required to achieve both qualifications. Candidates will cover a range of topics needed to provide effective first aid for adults, children and infants, including CPR and defibrillation, choking, stroke, head injuries, asthma and much more.
- **Age:** 17+.

- **Language:** Course delivered in English; Level 1 English assessment required before starting

## Assessments

- **Written:** There are 2 Multiple Choice Question (MCQ) papers for this course:
  - MCQ assessment 1 – Maximum time allowed: 40 mins – Minimum score to be considered for a pass: 14 out of 20
  - MCQ assessment 2 – Maximum time allowed: 40 mins – Minimum score to be considered for a pass: 18 out of 25

**Practical assessment:** There are nine practical assessments for this course:

- Adult CPR and safe use of an AED
- Child CPR and safe use of an AED
- Infant CPR and safe use of an AED
- Unconscious casualty
- Choking casualty
- Wounds, bleeding and shock
- Management of fractures
- Management of anaphylaxis
- Secondary survey

## What to Bring

- **Equipment Provided:** Manual (available for purchase), pens, pencils, notepaper
- **Recommended:** Please wear comfortable clothes; the practical training and assessments will be conducted on the classroom floor. Therefore, dresses and shirts are not advised to be worn. Please do not wear Crocs, Flip-flops or similar. Trousers, training shoes, and suitable tops are advised to be worn.
- **Identification:** Valid photo ID (passport, UK driving licence, etc.)


## Language Prerequisite


- Must demonstrate English/Welsh language skills equivalent to B2 CEFR or Level 1 Functional Skills/ESOL
