Access to bePractical DIY Workshop is via the front door, on the Brislington Hill parade of shops. The shop is currently hidden behind a large scaffolding installation which is surrounding the large block of flats, Gilton House. This makes us quite difficult to find.

On Foot

If you head towards St Peter's Hospice Shop, you will see the scaffolding right in front of it. Face up the hill, looking straight at St Peters Hospice Shop, bePractical is on the left of the scaffolding, next door to Blu-Fire Grill.

By Car....

There is **free parking** to the rear of our DIY workshop, accessed from Glenarm Walk. **What Three Words:** ///gosh.calls.straw

Driving from Bristol Town Centre along the A4 towards Bath...

At the Texaco Garage at the bottom of Brislington Hill, turn **left** into Church Walk. There is a small sign indicating Shoppers Parking, but its not very visible & it's the only indicator that you are given.



As soon as you turn into Church Walk, turn right, slightly uphill into Glenarm Walk.



About 20 metres up the road on the right, opposite the green sign for "Woodland House" there is a small (unmarked) road going up a hill towards the back of the shops. This road leads to the car park.

If you drive as far as the Church, you have gone too far, and missed the turning to the Car Park



Follow the lane up the hill into the Car park. You can park within any of the bays.



There is a walkway directly ahead of you in the Car Park, next to the Clothes Recycling Bin, which takes you down between the shops and out into the Parade:



Turn left at the bottom of the walkway and walk up, alongside the shops, and the lovely new murals on the pedestrian walkway, towards the scaffolding. You will find us on the left, nestling under the scaffolding, next to Blu-Fire Grill



By Bus
