

Little Wild Things Privacy Policy

At Little Wild Things we take your privacy seriously and will only ask for details about you and your children to ensure our sessions are safe and appropriate for your family.

When you book a Little Wild Things session through Bookwhen:

- We will ask for your name, number and email address, your child's name, age and any relevant allergies or medical conditions. We will ask for your permission to take photos that may be used on our website, social media or in our advertising. This is to:
 - o ensure we can provide a personalised and age-appropriate session for your family.
 - o ensure the snacks we provide are safe and suitable for your child.
 - o ensure we are aware of any relevant medical conditions so that we can plan sessions appropriately and maintain Little Wild Things as an activity that is accessible to all.
 - o enable us to contact you by phone or email in the unlikely event that a session needs to be cancelled, or if there is a problem with your booking.
 - o ensure that we only use pictures of families which we have permission.
- The data you provide will only be stored on the Bookwhen secure server, based in the United Kingdom.
- Your personal information will never be shared with any third parties.
- We will store this data for 18 months for our reference and accounts and then we will delete it.
- You may contact Little Wild Things at any time to enquire about the information we hold on you and to ask us to update or delete it.

When you attend a Little Wild Things adventure:

- Only photographs in which we have permission for everyone visible and identifiable will be kept. Photographs are kept on an external server and can only be accessed by authorised personnel.
- If you change your mind about our use of any photograph you may contact us at any time and ask us to move or delete it.
